Hyakunin Isshu are a kind of karuta, Japanese traditional playing cards. It is also the name of the game in which they are used. The game is played mostly on Japanese New Year's holidays. On each card, a poem (waka) is written, and there are a total of 100 poems. The standard collection of the poems used is called Hyakunin Isshu, which is often also the name of the game. The collection was chosen by a poet Fujiwara no Teika in Heian period. There are national conventions for the game.

Game rule:

Cards; There are 3 kinds of cards.

① male ② Princess ③ monk

Turn the picture card over and make a pile.

How to play;

Turn over a card one by one in order.

When a man comes out (54 cards): You can collect it as your own card.

When a princess card appears (21 cards): You can collect all the discarded cards on the table.

If there are no discarded, you can take one more time.

When a monk appears (12 cards): You lose all the cards at your hand. Put all the cards next to the pile.

When a soldier's card appears (a man holding a bow) (5 people): You can get all the cards of the person on the left. And the game round reverse.

When the emperor appears (3 cards): You can get all the cards from the players.

When the pile of cards runs out, the person with the most cards wins.

Presentation
